



Tough Bugga – Event Rules Please read carefully!!

Venue: 376 Manawahe Road



This is a team event for team of up to 10 people. It is a team challenge with the aim of completing the course by helping you team members to get through. There will be mud, water and challenges to complete. This is not a race, it is a challenge.

The Course

There are 3 categories:

3km for beginners.

5km

10km

All team members must stay together at ALL times.

Mystery Activities

There are mystery activities on the course.

Prizes

Spot Prizes will be given out once all competitors have finished.

Requirements to start

-Registration by team captain.

-Entry fee has been paid in full.

Waiver form has been signed by team captain and for all children under 18 years.

Team Categories

All teams can have up to 10 people

Children under 8 years old must have an adult (over 18years) in their team.

It is strongly advised that children under 8 years old do the beginners 3km course.

Each team member enters under their own responsibility (those under 18 years of age must have written consent from their parent or guardian). The parent / guardian can judge whether the child should participate in the event, start and continue to the finish line. Nevertheless, the organisers reserve the right to stop a competitor or team from setting off or continuing the race.

Insurance

All participants compete at their own risk and the organizers will not accept liability for any personal accident or injury during the event. A liability waiver form has to be signed by the Team Captain on behalf of the team. Competitors should ensure that they are adequately insured. Competitors under 18years of age must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

Safety

We make the course as safe as possible. You are responsible for your own safety though so if you feel uncomfortable at all you may choose not to complete a challenge.

Team Gear List

-All participants must wear shoes.

-Please bring snacks and water for any children participating.

-Please bring clothing appropriate for the weather conditions.

Officials

Participants must respect instructions given by the officials and must also follow their decisions regarding health security and safety.

Race Cancellation

There will be a 50% refund of entry fees per team in the event that the race is cancelled due to forces outside the organizers control such as weather. However we will do our best to postpone the event.

Team Entry Cancellation

There will not be any entry refunds after 10th November 2017. Any cancellations prior to this will incur a 50% administration fee.

Withdrawal

In case of withdrawal of a competitor or entire team, the captain must inform the organisers by any means available in the shortest possible time. If a team member pulls out of the race, you can continue the race as long as there are at least 2 people left in the team.

Finishing the Challenge

All competitors are signed off at the finish line. If you do not complete the course for any reason please go to the finish line to let them know.
